TRAVEL & BUSES

1. Each time we load the bus, go directly to your seat and sit down so the roll may be checked. This includes all rest stops.
2. Officers check roll and report to the chaperones when you are finished.
3. When we stop, remain seated and quiet until all instructions are given and you are told to unload.
4. Do not be late for loading times.
5. No horseplay on the buses.
6. Male and female relationships will be under observation at all times. We expect mature behavior from all students and expect cooperation in an effort to leave the BEST IMPRESSIONS of our band.
7. The bus is air-conditioned.
8. If you feel sick, please let chaperones know immediately so we can help!!
9. Each student is asked to police his/her area of the bus for debris at each stop. **DO NOT THROW DEBRIS OFF THE BUS!**
10. Chaperones should help us see that garbage bags are on the bus and are used!
11. All personal music devices must be used with headphones at a **VOLUME OTHERS CANNOT HEAR.**
12. Wearing apparel at rest stops is the same as your travel clothes. Students must be neat, buttons buttoned, shirt tails in, hair combed, shoes on, etc., or you will not be allowed to leave the bus.
13. Students must stay in groups of 3 or more! No running!
14. Attached you will find a complete itinerary including contact information!

HOTEL

1. Local calls will probably cost you extra. Please use phone cards or call home collect from your room. **Better check the roaming charges on your cell phone before you leave!!** Room charges must be cleared by Fri. & Monday evening. If you pay with cash get a receipt & the name of the hotel clerk. Chaperones will remind you!!! Save money for meals on Tuesday!!!!
2. Do not open the door to your room after curfew without permission from a chaperone or director. No room-to-room calls after curfew. If you have a problem, call your chaperones room for help (get the room number from your chaperon)! **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR ROOM WITHOUT PERMISSION BEFORE 6:00A.M.!**
3. You are reminded that there will be other guests at the motel. They are there for rest, so especially after 10:00 p.m., respect their right to quiet.
4. No running in the motel. (**Shoes on when walking in the hall**)
5. Curfews will be strictly observed. Curfews set on arrival at motel depends on maturity of your behavior and spirit of cooperation!!
6. Room captains are the top names on the room list. Their responsibilities will be as follows:
 - A. When you get to your room, inspect the room carefully for damage and furnishings that do not work. Report any damage you find in your room immediately to your chaperone. If you do not report problems, many hotels will assume we did the damage!
 - B. Pick up keys to your room when we arrive. Everyone should get their own key.
 - C. Be sure that everyone is up at the required time in the morning. (Take an alarm clock) (Do not count on hotel wake-up calls)
 - D. **See that the room is left neat each morning. (Any mess will result in room members being confined to room in the evening until situation is remedied.) PUT ALL GARBAGE IN THE TRASH CAN.**
 - E. Report any illness or other problems in your room to your chaperone.
 - F. **Return all room keys to your chaperone when we check out of each hotel. Wait in your room on check out morning until a chaperon comes to pick up your keys!!**
7. Police your room every morning before we leave, hang up clothes, pick up debris etc. See rule D. **THERE ARE INDOOR POOLS AT BOTH HOTELS.**
8. When we leave do not take hotel towels, washcloths, ashtrays, or any other hotel property. Charges will be applied to your band students account.

DRESS CODE

Bring a variety of clothing and be prepared to make the best of inclement weather conditions. Bring clothes for cool days and cold evenings, just in case. Save your patched and torn jeans for the motel. Shorts of a modest nature will be acceptable as we tour, but remember, you are the only person from Murfreesboro that some people will see. Our school dress code for the wording on T-shirts will be honored. Make it a good first impression. **Do your best to represent our school and community with pride!!!**

BRING:

- ___ ALARM CLOCK and A WATCH (even if you don't usually wear one!)
- ___ Money for 13 meals (approx \$95, snacks, and Souvenirs (Friday dinner and Sat. Lunch are provided.) (Travelers checks may be used, if you wish!)
- ___ Appropriate clothing (Jacket and/or sweaters for cooler weather)
- ___ Snacks for the bus and your room
- ___ Camera
- ___ Toiletry items
- ___ Your itinerary (**leave a copy with your parents**)
- ___ Personal sound system **and head phones**
- ___ "G or PG" rated DVD's, show music ideas for next year if you wish, Drum Corp DVD's etc.

RULES CONCERNING BEHAVIOR OF COUPLES

1. Hand holding is permissible, but other displays of affection will not be tolerated.
2. When young men & women are visiting in the same room, there must be minimum of five (5) persons. (This is a privilege to keep the hallway from being so noisy. Do not abuse this privilege!) First offence removes visitation for remainder of trip and puts students at front of bus with chaperons!!
3. The door must remain open and the curtains open at all times when young men & women are present in the room.
4. No boy/girl couples (even friends) together on the same bed at any time, in any way, shape, form, or fashion! This means not for "just talking" or "just watching a movie".
5. On the bus, no couples will sit together from 12 am (midnight) to sunrise.

Chaperones and Band Officers are to report any violation of these rules immediately to Mr. Meers & Mr. Aymett. At the hotels, they will be making random, unexpected visits to rooms to make sure the rules are being followed. (So it would be a good idea to watch the behavior of yourself and others and "police" yourselves.) Band officers & section leaders should be responsible for helping to encourage compliance!

*****Persons caught breaking the rules will sit in the front of the bus, with the chaperones. Also, all visitation rights at the hotel will be taken away from these persons. Occasionally we have to assign students to stay with chaperons during touring and our visit to Canada's Wonderland. Be accountable for your actions and think ahead! You represent Riverdale High School and our Band*****
