Grading • Students will be at all scheduled rehearsals and performances in order to receive full marks for their grades. • Student grades will be derived from attendance at all rehearsals and performances, assessments (playing and written), and daily participation. • The grading scale will follow the system currently in use by Rutherford County Schools and Riverdale High School. Grades can be viewed anytime by visiting the school’s Skyward portal.

Concert Band Uniform • “Concert black” – includes tuxedos or tux shirt with black suit and bow tie for men, similarly formal long solid black gown or blouse/black pantsuit for women.
