**Grading** • Students will be at all scheduled rehearsals and performances in order to receive full marks for their grades. • Student grades will be derived from attendance at all rehearsals and performances, assessments (playing and written), and daily participation. • The grading scale will follow the system currently in use by Rutherford County Schools and Riverdale High School.

**Concert Band Uniform** • “Concert black” – includes tuxedos or tux shirt with black suit and bow tie for men, similarly formal long solid black gown or blouse/black pantsuit for women.
